These veneer sheets, called Oyster Shell patterns, are a new type of wood veneer made up from a log that's been sliced through the trunk as opposed to along the trunk as is with typical veneers. They unroll with an adhesive back and come in stock panel dimensions of 4'x8' and 4'x10'.
