

veneer of the month: Smoked Red Gum

From southern Connecticut to Central Florida, [this domestic](#) specie grows up to 30 meters tall with diameters reaching up to 3 meters. The figured heartwood is highly valuable in architectural worldwide. The sapwood is cream-colored and relatively uniform; the heart wood is of a reddish to dark-brown color both of which can alternate within one single log, thus creating a beautiful marble effect. When [smoked](#) these colors transform and take on a whole new decorative effect. (BONUS: The heart wood often has a silky sheen therefore it's been coined the name "Satin Walnut.")
